## ABOUT THE CAMP

### ELIGIBILITY

This Teacher Training Workshop and Teaching Immersion Camp is offered to interested candidates with or without previous teaching experience. The following backgrounds are an asset:

- Music (any instrument)
- Education or music education
- Social science/psychology with basic musical skills on any musical instrument
- 'Special Education' training and background

Candidates must have a strong interest in community work with children in distinct communities, and in working with after-school programs run by NGO and/or not-for-profit organisations.

### COST

\$300 (August 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 in Montreal) +  
\$50 Registration (non- refundable)

### FEE INCLUDES

- 3 days of weekend Teacher Training Workshop (August 12, 13, 14): intense workshops, teacher training instruction, keynotes, individualized lesson plan creation, documents to support beginning Sistema teachers, lunch on Sunday, coffee breaks
- 3 days of practice teaching (August 15, 16, 17) at the FACE UP! day camp (<http://faceupmontreal.weebly.com/summer-camps.html>)

Additional \$200 extends the teaching experience at the overnight Camp Jouvence, Quebec (August 18, 19, 20). The fee includes: meals, lodging, transportation to and from Montreal, and additional teaching experience under the guidance of one of our Sistema head teachers.

Registration in the Teacher Training Workshop and Teaching Immersion Camp is obligatory for the extended overnight Camp Jouvence experience.

Limited scholarships for work-study positions are available.

### TEACHER TRAINING WORKSHOP AND TEACHING IMMERSION CAMP CONTENT:

Theoretical instruction (3 days: August 12, 13, 14)

- Sistema concepts/ethos
- Lesson planning/classroom management techniques
- Introduction to teaching instrumental music in a group (violin/winds)
- Supplementary musical skills include musical games and activities, fiddling, Orff, choir

Practical application/implementation (3 days: August 15, 16, 17)

- Teach 1-2 hours of music daily to students (ages 6-12) at the FACE UP! summer day camp, including students from Encore!Sistema Quebec sites
- Implement techniques studied at the Teacher Training workshops
- Acquire hands-on experience by implementing lesson plans developed during the weekend workshop
- Reflection sessions will follow the morning teaching and will include lesson plan development for the next day

### PARTICIPANTS WILL GAIN:

- Knowledge and insight into local Sistema-inspired programs
- Strategies for classroom management
- Guidance on lesson planning and curriculum development
- Strategies for instrumental music group instruction
- Hands-on practical experience by working with children from the Sistema programs and inner city schools (ages 6-12)
- Guidance/mentoring from a successful and experienced team of music educators, Sistema advocates and supporters
